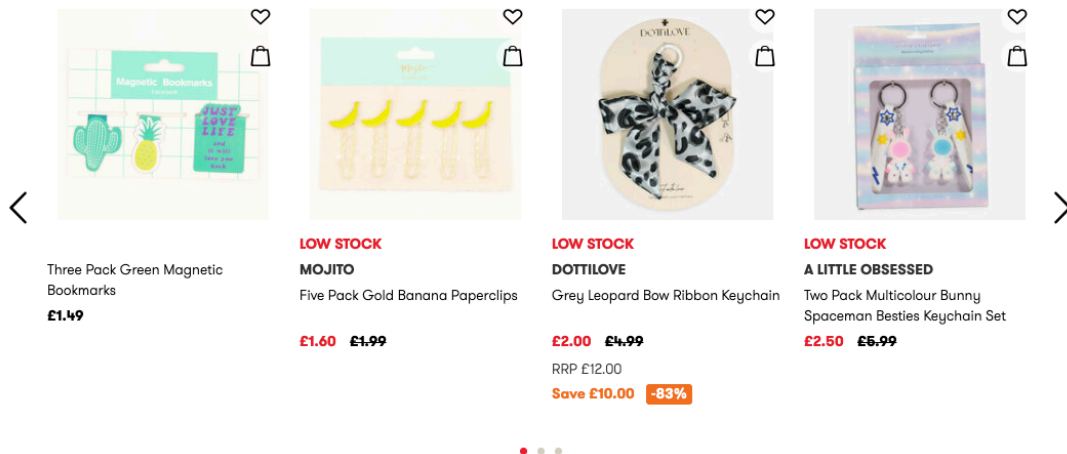
Gifts for teenage girls

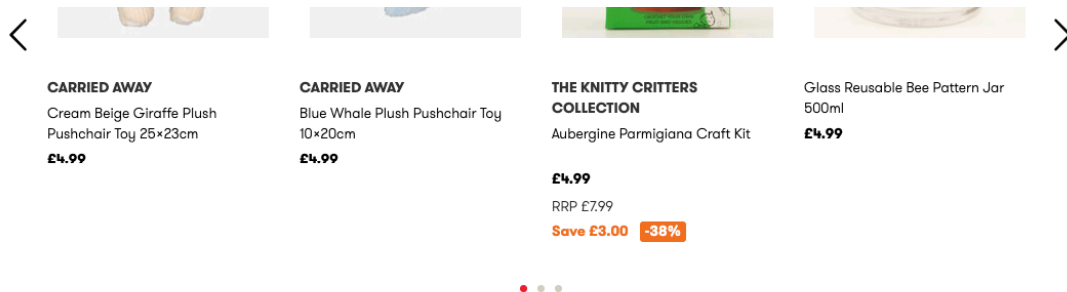
Birthday presents for teenagers
